## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to authorizing certain persons to file 2 documents 3 electronically for recording with a county clerk. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 195.003, Local Government Code, 5 is 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 7 read as follows: 8 (a) The following persons may file electronic documents or other documents electronically for recording with a county clerk 9 that accepts electronic filing and recording under this chapter: 10 an attorney licensed in this state; 11 (1)12 (2) a bank, savings and loan association, savings 13 bank, or credit union doing business under laws of the United States or this state; 14 15 (3) a federally chartered lending institution, а federal government-sponsored entity, an instrumentality of the 16 17 federal government, or a person approved as a mortgagee by the United States to make federally insured loans; 18 19 (4) a person licensed to make regulated loans in this 20 state; a title insurance company or title insurance agent 21 (5) 22 licensed to do business in this state; [or] (6) an agency of this state; or 23 24 (7) a municipal clerk.

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1	(a-1) In addition to persons listed under Subsection (a), a
2	county may authorize a person to file electronic documents or other
3	documents electronically for recording with a county clerk if the
4	county enters into a memorandum of understanding with the person
5	for that purpose. This subsection applies only to a county with a
6	population of 500,000 or more.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
