## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to management services for the physical facilities of the 2 3 Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the Texas 4 School for the Deaf. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 30.022, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (h-1) to read as 7 follows: 8 Except as provided by Subsection (h-1), the [The] board 9 (h) 10 has [exclusive] jurisdiction over the physical assets of the school and shall administer and spend appropriations made for the benefit 11 12 of the school. 13 (h-1) The Texas Facilities Commission shall provide facilities maintenance services for the physical facilities of the 14 15 school, including facilities construction, cabling, facility reconfiguration, and any other services as provided by a memorandum 16 17 of understanding between the board and the Texas Facilities 18 Commission. SECTION 2. Section 30.052, Education Code, is amended by 19 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (h-1) to read as 20 21 follows: 22 (h) Except as provided by Subsection (h-1), the [The] board has [exclusive] jurisdiction over the physical assets of the school 23

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and shall administer and spend appropriations to carry out the

1 purposes of the school as provided by Section 30.051.

2 <u>(h-1) The Texas Facilities Commission shall provide</u> 3 facilities maintenance services for the physical facilities of the 4 school, including facilities construction, cabling, facility 5 reconfiguration, and any other services as provided by a memorandum 6 of understanding between the board and the Texas Facilities 7 Commission.

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SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 2165.007, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission shall 11 provide facilities management services in relation to all state 12 agency facilities in Travis County or a county adjacent to Travis 13 County. The commission's duty does not apply to:

14 (1) a facility owned or operated by an institution of 15 higher education;

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(2) military facilities;

17 (3) facilities owned or operated by the Texas18 Department of Criminal Justice;

19 (4) facilities owned or operated by the Texas <u>Juvenile</u>
 20 <u>Justice Department</u> [<del>Youth Commission</del>];

21 (5) facilities owned or operated by the Texas 22 Department of Transportation;

(6) the Capitol, including the Capitol Extension, the
General Land Office building, the Bob Bullock Texas State History
Museum, any museum located on the Capitol grounds, the Governor's
Mansion, and any property maintained by the Texas Historical
Commission under Sections 442.0072 and 442.0073;

(7) a facility determined by the commission to be
 completely residential;

3 (8) a regional or field office of a state agency;
4 (9) a facility located within or on state park
5 property;

6 (10) the property known as the Finance Commission
7 Building described by deed recorded in Volume 5080, Page 1099, of
8 the Deed Records of Travis County, Texas; [<del>or</del>]

9 (11) the property known as the Credit Union Department 10 Building described by deed recorded in Volume 6126, Page 27, of the 11 Deed Records of Travis County, Texas;

12 (12) facilities owned or operated by the Texas School 13 for the Blind and Visually Impaired; or

14 (13) facilities owned or operated by the Texas School 15 for the Deaf.

16 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than January 1, 2014, the 17 following are transferred from the Texas School for the Blind and 18 Visually Impaired to the Texas Facilities Commission:

(1) the powers, duties, functions, programs, and
activities of the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired
relating to the maintenance of the school's physical facilities;

(2) any obligations and contracts of the Texas School
for the Blind and Visually Impaired that are directly related to
implementing a power, duty, function, program, or activity
transferred under this subsection; and

(3) all property and records in the custody of the27 Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired that are related to

a power, duty, function, program, or activity transferred under
 this subsection and all funds appropriated by the legislature for
 that power, duty, function, program, or activity.

(b) The Texas Facilities Commission and the Texas School for
the Blind and Visually Impaired shall enter into a memorandum of
understanding as provided by Subsection (h-1), Section 30.022,
Education Code, as added by this Act, that:

8 (1) identifies in detail the applicable powers and 9 duties that are transferred between the two agencies by this Act; 10 and

11 (2) establishes a plan for the identification and 12 transfer of the records, personnel, property, and unspent 13 appropriations of the Texas School for the Blind and Visually 14 Impaired that are used for purposes of the commission's powers and 15 duties directly related to the maintenance of the school's physical 16 facilities under Section 30.022, Education Code.

17 SECTION 5. (a) Not later than January 1, 2014, the 18 following are transferred from the Texas School for the Deaf to the 19 Texas Facilities Commission:

(1) the powers, duties, functions, programs, and activities of the Texas School for the Deaf relating to the maintenance of the school's physical facilities;

(2) any obligations and contracts of the Texas School
for the Deaf that are directly related to implementing a power,
duty, function, program, or activity transferred under this
subsection; and

27 (3) all property and records in the custody of the

Texas School for the Deaf that are related to a power, duty,
 function, program, or activity transferred under this subsection
 and all funds appropriated by the legislature for that power, duty,
 function, program, or activity.

5 (b) The Texas Facilities Commission and the Texas School for 6 the Deaf shall enter into a memorandum of understanding as provided 7 by Subsection (h-1), Section 30.052, Education Code, as added by 8 this Act, that:

9 (1) identifies in detail the applicable powers and 10 duties that are transferred between the two agencies by this Act; 11 and

12 (2) establishes a plan for the identification and 13 transfer of the records, personnel, property, and unspent 14 appropriations of the Texas School for the Deaf that are used for 15 purposes of the commission's powers and duties directly related to 16 the maintenance of the school's physical facilities under Section 17 30.052, Education Code.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
