2	relating to the adoption of major curriculum initiatives by a
3	school district.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.002(g), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(g) A local instructional plan may draw on state curriculum
8	frameworks and program standards as appropriate. Each district is
9	encouraged to exceed minimum requirements of law and State Board of
10	Education rule. Each district shall ensure that all children in the
11	district participate actively in a balanced curriculum designed to
12	meet individual needs. Before the adoption of a major curriculum
13	initiative, including the use of a curriculum management system, a
14	district must use a process that:
15	(1) includes teacher input;
16	(2) provides district employees with the opportunity
17	to express opinions regarding the initiative; and
18	(3) includes a meeting of the board of trustees of the
19	district at which:
20	(A) information regarding the initiative is
21	presented, including the cost of the initiative and any
22	alternatives that were considered; and

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are given the opportunity to comment regarding the initiative.

(B) members of the public and district employees

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- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
