## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to health benefit plan coverage for enrollees diagnosed
- 3 with autism spectrum disorder.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1355.015, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c-1) and (f) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) At a minimum, a health benefit plan must provide
- 9 coverage as provided by this section to an enrollee who is diagnosed
- 10 with autism spectrum disorder from the date of diagnosis, only if
- 11 the diagnosis was in place prior to the child's 10th birthday [until
- 12 the enrollee completes nine years of age. If an enrollee who is
- 13 being treated for autism spectrum disorder becomes 10 years of age
- 14 or older and continues to need treatment, this subsection does not
- 15 preclude coverage of treatment and services described by Subsection
- 16 <del>(b)</del>].
- 17 (c-1) The health benefit plan is not required to provide
- 18 coverage under Subsection (b) for benefits for an enrollee 10 years
- 19 of age or older for applied behavior analysis in an amount that
- 20 <u>exceeds \$36,000 per year.</u>
- 21 (f) To the extent that this section would otherwise require
- 22 this state to make a payment under 42 U.S.C. Section
- 23 18031(d)(3)(B)(ii), a qualified health plan, as defined by 45
- 24 C.F.R. Section 155.20, is not required to provide a benefit under

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- 1 this section that exceeds the specified essential health benefits
- 2 required under 42 U.S.C. Section 18022(b).
- 3 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 1355.015, Insurance Code,
- 4 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1355.015. REQUIRED COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN <u>ENROLLEES</u>
- 6 [CHILDREN].
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 1355.015, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is delivered,
- 9 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act. A health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for
- 11 delivery, or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 12 covered by the law in effect at the time the health benefit plan is
- 13 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed, and that law is
- 14 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
