- 2 relating to the abandonment of a county road.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 251.057 (b), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 251.057. Abandonment of County Road. (a) A county road
- 7 is abandoned when its use has become so infrequent that one or more
- 8 adjoining property owners have enclosed the road with a fence
- 9 continuously for at least 20 years. The abandoned road may be
- 10 reestablished as a public road only in the manner provided for
- 11 establishing a new road.
- 12 (b) This section does not apply to:
- 13 (1) a road to a cemetery <u>unless an adjoining property</u>
- 14 owner files an affidavit in the deed records, at any time after the
- 15 expiration of the 20-year period provided in subsection (a),
- 16 agreeing to provide reasonable access to the cemetery pursuant to
- 17 Health & Safety Code Section 711.92 as it existed on September 1,
- 18 2013; or
- 19 (2) an access road that is reasonably necessary to
- 20 reach adjoining real property.
- 21 Section 2. This Act takes affect September 1, 2013.
