3	(d) A designated district shall meet performance measures
4	developed under Subsection (b) in order to maintain a designation
5	under this section.
6	(e) The commission may amend the boundaries of a district to
7	include private sector development.
8	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
