- 3 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an application for
- 4 financial assistance filed with the Texas Water Development Board
- 5 on or after the effective date of this Act. An application for
- 6 financial assistance filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 7 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed,
- 8 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
