A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the confidentiality of certain crime scene photographs
3	and video recordings.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.1085 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.1085. CONFIDENTIALITY OF SENSITIVE CRIME SCENE
8	<pre>IMAGE. (a) In this section:</pre>
9	(1) "Deceased person's next of kin" means:
10	(A) the surviving spouse of the deceased person;
11	(B) if there is no surviving spouse of the
12	deceased, an adult child of the deceased person; or
13	(C) if there is no surviving spouse or adult
14	child of the deceased, a parent of the deceased person.
15	(2) "Defendant" means a person being prosecuted for
16	the death of the deceased person or a person convicted of an offense
17	in relation to that death and appealing that conviction.
18	(3) "Expressive work" means:
19	(A) a fictional or nonfictional entertainment,
20	dramatic, literary, or musical work that is a play, book, article,
21	musical composition, audiovisual work, radio or television
22	program, work of art, or work of political, educational, or
23	newsworthy value;
24	(B) a work the primary function of which is the

- 1 delivery of news, information, current events, or other matters of
- 2 public interest or concern; or
- 3 (C) an advertisement or commercial announcement
- 4 of a work described by Paragraph (A) or (B).
- 5 (4) "Local governmental entity" means a county,
- 6 municipality, school district, charter school, junior college
- 7 district, or other political subdivision of this state.
- 8 <u>(5) "Public or private institution of higher</u>
- 9 education" means:
- 10 (A) an institution of higher education, as
- 11 <u>defined by Section 61.003, Education Code; or</u>
- 12 <u>(B) a private or independent institution of</u>
- 13 higher education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 14 (6) "Sensitive crime scene image" means a photograph
- 15 or video recording taken at a crime scene, contained in or part of a
- 16 closed criminal case, that depicts a deceased person in a state of
- 17 dismemberment, decapitation, or similar mutilation or that depicts
- 18 the deceased person's genitalia.
- 19 (7) "State agency" means a department, commission,
- 20 board, office, or other agency that is a part of state government
- 21 and that is created by the constitution or a statute of this state.
- 22 The term includes an institution of higher education as defined by
- 23 Section 61.003, Education Code.
- (b) For purposes of this section, an Internet website, the
- 25 primary function of which is not the delivery of news, information,
- 26 current events, or other matters of public interest or concern, is
- 27 not an expressive work.

Τ	(c) A sensitive crime scene image in the custody of a
2	governmental body is confidential and excepted from the
3	requirements of Section 552.021 and a governmental body may not
4	permit a person to view or copy the image except as provided by this
5	section. This section applies to any sensitive crime scene image
6	regardless of the date that the image was taken or recorded.
7	(d) Notwithstanding Subsection (c) and subject to
8	Subsection (e), the following persons may view or copy information
9	that constitutes a sensitive crime scene image from a governmental
10	body:
11	(1) the deceased person's next of kin;
12	(2) a person authorized in writing by the deceased
13	person's next of kin;
14	(3) a defendant or the defendant's attorney;
15	(4) a person who establishes to the governmental body
16	an interest in a sensitive crime scene image that is based on,
17	connected with, or in support of the creation, in any medium, of an
18	expressive work;
19	(5) a person performing bona fide research sponsored
20	by a public or private institution of higher education with
21	approval of a supervisor of the research or a supervising faculty
22	member;
23	(6) a state agency;
24	(7) an agency of the federal government; or
25	(8) a local governmental entity.
26	(e) This section does not prohibit a governmental body from
27	asserting an exception to disclosure of a sensitive crime scene

- 1 image to a person identified in Subsection (d) on the grounds that
- 2 the image is excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021
- 3 under another provision of this chapter or another law.
- 4 (f) Not later than the 10th business day after the date a
- 5 governmental body receives a request for a sensitive crime scene
- 6 image from a person described by Subsection (d)(4) or (5), the
- 7 governmental body shall notify the deceased person's next of kin of
- 8 the request in writing. The notice must be sent to the next of kin's
- 9 last known address.
- 10 (g) A governmental body that receives a request for
- 11 information that constitutes a sensitive crime scene image shall
- 12 allow a person described in Subsection (d) to view or copy the image
- 13 not later than the 10th business day after the date the governmental
- 14 body receives the request unless the governmental body files a
- 15 request for an attorney general decision under Subchapter G
- 16 regarding whether an exception to public disclosure applies to the
- 17 <u>information</u>.
- 18 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 19 only to the disclosure or copying of a sensitive crime scene image
- 20 on or after September 1, 2013.
- 21 (b) The disclosure or copying of a sensitive crime scene
- 22 image before September 1, 2013, is covered by the law in effect when
- 23 the image was disclosed or copied, and the former law is continued
- 24 in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
