Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 51.9195 to read as follows: Sec. 51.9195. INFORMATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS 8 REGARDING BENEFITS OF TIMELY GRADUATION. (a) In this section, 9 "general academic teaching institution" has the meaning assigned by 10 Section 61.003. 11 12 (b) Each general academic teaching institution shall provide to each first-time entering undergraduate student, 13 14 including each undergraduate student who transfers to the institution, a statement that includes: 15 16 (1) a comparison of the average total academic costs paid by a full-time student who graduates from the institution in 17 the following number of academic years: 18 19 (A) four years; 20 (B) five years; and 21 (C) six years; and (2) an estimate of the average earnings lost by a 22 23 recent graduate of the institution as a result of graduating after five or six years instead of four years. 24

(c) A general academic teaching institution shall include 1 2 with the statement provided to a student under Subsection (b): (1) a list of actions that the student can take to 3 4 facilitate graduating from the institution in a timely manner; and (2) contact information for available academic, 5 6 career, and other related support services at the institution to 7 assist the student in that effort. (d) In consultation with general academic teaching 8 institutions, the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall 9 adopt any rules the coordinating board considers appropriate for 10 the administration of this section. 11 SECTION 2. Section 51.9195, Education Code, as added by 12 this Act, applies beginning with undergraduate students who 13 14 initially enroll in a general academic teaching institution for the 15 2014 fall semester. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
