## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT
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- 2 relating to evaluating the performance, including computing
- 3 dropout and completion rates, of public schools designated as
- 4 dropout recovery schools.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 39.0545 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 39.0545. EVALUATING DROPOUT RECOVERY SCHOOLS.
- 9 (a) For purposes of evaluating performance under Section
- 10 39.053(c), the commissioner shall designate as a dropout recovery
- 11 school a school district or an open-enrollment charter school or a
- 12 campus of a district or of an open-enrollment charter school:
- 13 (1) that serves students in grades 9 through 12 and has
- 14 <u>an enrollment of which at least 50 percent of the students are 17</u>
- 15 years of age or older as of September 1 of the school year as
- 16 reported for the fall semester Public Education Information
- 17 Management System (PEIMS) submission; and
- 18 (2) that meets the eligibility requirements for and is
- 19 registered under alternative education accountability procedures
- 20 <u>adopted by the commissioner.</u>
- 21 (b) Notwithstanding Section 39.053(c)(2), the commissioner
- 22 shall use the alternative completion rate under this subsection to
- 23 determine the student achievement indicator under Section
- 24 39.053(c)(2) for a dropout recovery school. The alternative

- 1 completion rate shall be the ratio of the total number of students
- 2 who graduate, continue attending school into the next academic
- 3 year, or receive a high school equivalency certificate to the total
- 4 number of students in the longitudinal cohort of students.
- 5 (c) Notwithstanding Section 39.053(c)(2), in determining
- 6 the performance rating under Section 39.054 of a dropout recovery
- 7 school, the commissioner shall include any student described by
- 8 Section 39.053(g-1) who graduates or receives a high school
- 9 equivalency certificate.
- 10 (d) For a dropout recovery school, only the best result from
- 11 the primary administration and any retake of an assessment
- 12 instrument administered to a student in the school year evaluated
- 13 under the accountability procedures adopted by the commissioner may
- 14 be considered in determining the performance rating of the school
- 15 under Section 39.054.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 17 school year.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
