A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to professional development training for certain public school personnel regarding student disciplinary procedures. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 37.0181 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 37.0181. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT REGARDING DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES. (a) Each principal or other appropriate 8 9 administrator who oversees student discipline shall, at least once every three school years, attend professional development training 10 regarding this subchapter, including training relating to the 11 distinction between a discipline management technique used at the 12 principal's discretion under Section 37.002(a) and the 13 discretionary authority of a teacher to remove a disruptive student 14 under Section 37.002(b). 15 16 (b) Professional development training under this section may be provided in coordination with regional education service 17 centers through the use of distance learning methods, such as 18 19 telecommunications networks, and using available agency resources. 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014 school year. 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 23

23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
