AN ACT

- 2 relating to pre-event disaster recovery program administration
- 3 contracts in certain counties.

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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 418.127 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.127. PRE-EVENT DISASTER RECOVERY PROGRAM
- 8 CONTRACTS. (a) The General Land Office shall enter into a
- 9 pre-event disaster recovery program administration contract with
- 10 <u>each regional planning commission, council of governments, or</u>
- 11 similar regional planning agency created under Chapter 391, Local
- 12 Government Code, whose membership includes at least one county that
- 13 borders the Gulf of Mexico.
- 14 (b) The General Land Office shall activate a contract
- 15 required by this section in a county that is designated as a
- 16 threatened area in:
- 17 (1) an executive order or proclamation declaring a
- 18 state of disaster issued by the governor; or
- (2) a disaster declaration by the president of the
- 20 <u>United States.</u>
- 21 (c) Services obtained under a contract required under this
- 22 section may be paid for with money from the disaster contingency
- 23 fund under Section 418.073.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
