- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 63, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 63.004 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 63.004. DUNE PROJECT EASEMENT. (a) For the purposes of
- 8 this section, "dune project" means a project to construct and
- 9 maintain a vegetated stabilized dune on a beach for protection
- 10 against avulsive events.
- 11 (b) A person who owns property that borders a line of
- 12 vegetation establishing the boundary of a public beach may grant an
- 13 <u>easement on the property to this state, a county, or a municipality</u>
- 14 for the purpose of allowing the governmental entity to construct
- 15 and maintain a dune project in the easement.
- (c) A person may not grant an easement under Subsection (b)
- 17 unless the person simultaneously grants to the public a
- 18 recreational easement on the portion of the person's property
- 19 seaward of the seaward boundary of the easement granted under that
- 20 subsection.
- 21 (d) An agreement between a person who grants an easement
- 22 under Subsection (b) and this state, a county, or a municipality may
- 23 provide that the seaward boundary of the easement may be affected by

- 2 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 3 to an easement granted on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 An easement granted before the effective date of this Act is
- 5 governed by the law in effect on the date the easement was granted,
- 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
