4	SECTION 1. Section 552.002, Government Code, is amended to

6	Sec. 552.002. DEFINITION OF PUBLIC INFORMATION; MEDIA
7	CONTAINING PUBLIC INFORMATION. (a) In this chapter, "public
8	information" means information that is written, produced,
9	collected, assembled, or maintained under a law or ordinance or in
10	connection with the transaction of official business:
11	(1) by a governmental body; [or]
12	(2) for a governmental body and the governmental body:
13	(A) owns the information; $[extit{or}]$
14	(B) has a right of access to the information; or
15	(C) spends or contributes public money for the
16	purpose of writing, producing, collecting, assembling, or
17	maintaining the information; or
18	(3) by an individual officer or employee of a
19	governmental body in the officer's or employee's official capacity
20	and the information pertains to official business of the
21	governmental body [it].
22	(a-1) Information is in connection with the transaction of
23	official business if the information is created by, transmitted to,
24	received by, or maintained by an officer or employee of the

- 2 or a person or entity performing official business or a
- 3 governmental function on behalf of a governmental body, and
- 4 pertains to official business of the governmental body.
- 5 (a-2) The definition of "public information" provided by
- 6 Subsection (a) applies to and includes any electronic communication
- 7 created, transmitted, received, or maintained on any device if the
- 8 communication is in connection with the transaction of official
- 9 business.
- 10 (b) The media on which public information is recorded
- 11 include:
- 12 (1) paper;
- 13 (2) film;
- 14 (3) a magnetic, optical, [er] solid state, or other
- 15 device that can store an electronic signal;
- 16 (4) tape;
- 17 (5) Mylar; and
- 18 (6) any physical material on which information may be
- 19 recorded, including linen, [+
- 20 $\left[\frac{(7)}{}\right]$ silk, $\left[\frac{1}{7}\right]$ and
- $[\frac{8}{2}]$ vellum.
- (c) The general forms in which the media containing public
- 23 information exist include a book, paper, letter, document, e-mail,
- 24 Internet posting, text message, instant message, other electronic
- 25 communication, printout, photograph, film, tape, microfiche,
- 26 microfilm, photostat, sound recording, map, and drawing and a
- 27 voice, data, or video representation held in computer memory.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 552.003, Government Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
- 3 (2-a) "Official business" means any matter over which a
- 4 governmental body has or seeks to have any authority,
- 5 <u>administrative duties</u>, or advisory duties.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
