- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2251.106, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) The public insurance counsel may initiate a hearing on a
- 9 rate filing or a rate in effect filed under this chapter by filing a
- 10 written petition with the commissioner.
- 11 (e) The commissioner shall hold a hearing under Subsection
- 12 (d) not later than the 30th day after the date of the filing of the
- 13 written petition.
- 14 (f) The commissioner shall provide written notice of a
- 15 hearing under Subsection (d) to the office of public insurance
- 16 counsel and each insurer that made the rate filing not later than
- 17 the 10th day before the date of the hearing.
- 18 (g) The party that made the rate filing has the burden to
- 19 show that the rate filing meets the standards under Subchapter B.
- 20 (h) If, after the hearing, the commissioner determines that
- 21 the rate filing or rate in effect does not meet the requirements of
- 22 this chapter, the commissioner shall issue an order under Section
- 23 <u>2251.103(d) or 2251.104(b)</u>, as applicable.
- (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if

- 1 <u>a rate filing that is the subject of a hearing under Subsection (d)</u>
- 2 has not gone into effect as of the date the written petition is
- 3 filed, the subject rate may not go into effect until:
- 4 (1) the commissioner has entered an order finding that
- 5 the rate filing meets the standards under Subchapter B; or
- 6 (2) the filing is appealed and determined on final
- 7 appeal to meet the standards under Subchapter B.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
