## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 571.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 571.002. PURPOSE. The purpose of this subtitle is to
- 8 provide to each person having severe mental illness access to
- 9 humane care and treatment by:
- 10 (1) facilitating treatment in an appropriate setting;
- 11 (2) enabling the person to obtain necessary
- 12 evaluation, care, treatment, and rehabilitation with the least
- 13 possible trouble, expense, and embarrassment to the person and the
- 14 person's family;
- 15 (3) eliminating, if requested, the traumatic effect on
- 16 the person's mental health of public trial and criminal-like
- 17 procedures;
- 18 (4) protecting the person's right to a judicial
- 19 determination of the person's need for involuntary treatment;
- 20 (5) defining the criteria the state must meet to order
- 21 involuntary care and treatment;
- 22 (6) establishing the procedures to obtain facts, carry
- 23 out examinations, and make prompt and fair decisions;
- 24 (7) safeguarding the person's legal rights so as to

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- 1 advance and not impede the therapeutic and protective purposes of
- 2 involuntary care; [and]
- 3 (8) safeguarding the rights of the person who
- 4 voluntarily requests inpatient care;
- 5 (9) providing the person's treatment in the least
- 6 restrictive fashion;
- 7 (10) treating the person as a voluntary patient when
- 8 possible, including after commitment to involuntary mental health
- 9 services if the person requests voluntary services; and
- 10 (11) using involuntary interventions only as a last
- 11 resort and when necessary to protect the health and safety of the
- 12 person needing treatment or the safety of others, including
- 13 treatment providers.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
