- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 22.07(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) The chief appraiser or the chief appraiser's [his]
- 10 authorized representative may enter the premises of a business,
- 11 trade, or profession and inspect the property to determine the
- 12 existence and market value of tangible personal property used for
- 13 the production of income and having a taxable situs in the district,
- 14 provided that the owner of the business, trade, or profession has
- 15 expressly consented to the entry and inspection.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
