- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 73.115, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) In any contract for the acquisition of goods and
- 8 services to which an institution of higher education is a party, a
- 9 provision required by applicable law to be included in the contract
- 10 is considered to be a part of the executed contract without regard
- 11 to:
- 12 (1) whether the provision appears on the face of the
- 13 contract; or
- 14 (2) whether the contract includes any provision to the
- 15 contrary.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 64, Property Code, as added by Chapter
- 17 918, Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is
- 18 amended by adding Section 64.0011 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 64.0011. APPLICATION TO INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
- 20 EDUCATION. This chapter does not apply to residential property for
- 21 which an institution of higher education is a co-owner.
- SECTION 3. Section 66.08(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- 24 (d) The board of directors of the corporation shall have

- 1 nine members, determined as follows:
- 2 (1) $\underline{\text{seven}}$ [$\underline{\text{six}}$] members appointed by the board, of
- 3 whom:
- 4 (A) three must be members of the board; and
- 5 <u>(B)</u> [the other] three must have a substantial
- 6 background and expertise in investments; and
- 7 (C) one must be a qualified individual as
- 8 <u>determined by the board, which may include</u>
- 9 $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ the chancellor of The University of Texas System;
- 10 and
- 11 $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ two members appointed by the board of regents of The
- 12 Texas A&M University System, at least one of whom must have a
- 13 substantial background and expertise in investments.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 74.002, Education Code, is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
