 1-24 AN ACT

1-25 relating to ad valorem tax liens on personal property.  
 1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-27 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 32.01, Tax Code, is  
 1-28 amended to read as follows:  
 1-29 (b) A tax lien on inventory, furniture, equipment, or other  
 1-30 personal property is a lien in solido and attaches to all inventory,  
 1-31 furniture, equipment, and other personal property that the property  
 1-32 owner owns on January 1 of the year the lien attaches or that the  
 1-33 property owner subsequently acquires, irrespective of whether the  
 1-34 personal property is located within the boundaries of the taxing  
 1-35 unit in whose favor the lien attaches.  
 1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
