A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the transfer of the assets of and the dissolution of the
- 3 Dallas County Water Control and Improvement District No. 6.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 6 (1) "City" means the City of Balch Springs.
- 7 (2) "District" means the Dallas County Water Control
- 8 and Improvement District No. 6.
- 9 SECTION 2. TRANSFER OF ASSETS AND DISSOLUTION OF DISTRICT.
- 10 (a) On the date the city council of the city passes a resolution
- 11 accepting the assets, debts, and contractual rights and obligations
- 12 of the district:
- 13 (1) all assets, debts, and contractual rights and
- 14 obligations of the district are property of the city; and
- 15 (2) the district is dissolved.
- 16 (b) The city shall notify the Texas Commission on
- 17 Environmental Quality of the dissolution of the district.
- SECTION 3. NOTICE. (a) The legal notice of the intention
- 19 to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 20 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 21 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 22 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 23 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 24 Government Code.

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- 1 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 2 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 3 Environmental Quality.
- 4 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 5 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 6 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 7 representatives within the required time.
- 8 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 9 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 10 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 11 and accomplished.
- 12 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 13 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 14 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 15 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 16 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
