- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2303.403, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2303.403. PROHIBITION ON QUALIFIED BUSINESS
- 8 CERTIFICATION; LIMIT ON ENTERPRISE PROJECT DESIGNATIONS. (a) If
- 9 the bank determines that the governing body eligible to nominate an
- 10 enterprise project is not complying with this chapter, the bank
- 11 shall prohibit the certification of a qualified business until the
- 12 bank determines that the governing body is complying with this
- 13 chapter.
- 14 (b) The bank may not designate more than 105 enterprise
- 15 projects during any biennium. Any designations remaining at the
- 16 end of a biennium may be carried forward to the next biennium.
- 17 (c) The bank may allocate the total number of enterprise
- 18 project designations available in a biennium under Subsection (b)
- 19 among two annual or four semiannual periods so that a nearly equal
- 20 number of designations are available to be awarded in each annual or
- 21 <u>semiannual period</u>.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
