 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the allocation of enterprise project designations  
 1-18 during a biennium.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 2303.403, Government Code, is amended to  
 1-21 read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 2303.403. PROHIBITION ON QUALIFIED BUSINESS  
 1-23 CERTIFICATION; LIMIT ON ENTERPRISE PROJECT DESIGNATIONS. (a) If  
 1-24 the bank determines that the governing body eligible to nominate an  
 1-25 enterprise project is not complying with this chapter, the bank  
 1-26 shall prohibit the certification of a qualified business until the  
 1-27 bank determines that the governing body is complying with this  
 1-28 chapter.

1-29 (b) The bank may not designate more than 105 enterprise  
 1-30 projects during any biennium. Any designations remaining at the  
 1-31 end of a biennium may be carried forward to the next biennium.

1-32 (c) The bank may allocate the total number of enterprise  
 1-33 project designations available in a biennium under Subsection (b)  
 1-34 among two annual or four semiannual periods so that a nearly equal  
 1-35 number of designations are available to be awarded in each annual or  
 1-36 semiannual period.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
