9	this subtitle who submits an application for renewal of a license to												
10	practice medicine and who is also registered with the Department of												
11	Public Safety under Subchapter C, Chapter 481, Health and Safety												
12	Code, must complete three hours of continuing medical education												
13	relating to:												
14	(1) pain management using controlled substances and												
15	other methods; and												
16	(2) the use of the Prescription Access in Texas												
17	database administered by the Department of Public Safety to monitor												
18	the dispensing history of patients.												
19	(b) The hours of continuing education under this section are												
20	required in addition to the number of hours required to comply with												
21	Section 156.051 and apply to persons described by Section 156.052.												
22	(c) The board shall adopt rules to implement this section.												
23	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only												
24	to a physician whose registration under Chapter 156, Occupations
