S.B. No. 1655

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to authorizing the Public Utility Commission of Texas to 2 direct the comptroller to return the unappropriated balance of the 3 4 system benefit fund to retail electric customers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Section 39.9039 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 39.9039. DISBURSEMENT OF SYSTEM BENEFIT FUND BALANCE. 8 (a) After consultation with the comptroller, the commission by 9 10 rule shall establish a system for transmission and distribution utilities, retail electric providers, municipally owned utilities, 11 or electric cooperatives to credit retail electric customers' bills 12 in amounts necessary to expend as fully as practicable the 13 appropriated balance of the system benefit fund transferred to a 14 15 special fund outside of the general revenue fund by Section 30, Article VIII, Texas Const<u>itution, in accordance with this section.</u> 16 17 (b) The commission shall direct the comptroller to disburse as much as practicable of the balance described by Subsection (a) as 18 soon as practicable and before September 1, 2014, in one or more 19 installments to transmission and distribution utilities, retail 20 electric providers, municipally owned utilities, or electric 21 cooperatives under the system established under Subsection (a) so 22 that each entity receives an amount necessary to give each retail 23 24 electric customer that has customer choice an equal credit so that

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1 the total of the credits equals the total amount disbursed. 2 (c) The commission by rule shall require each entity receiving disbursements under this section to ensure that retail 3 4 electric customers that have customer choice, through one or more 5 billings for electric services between the time the entity receives a disbursement under this section and August 31, 2014, each receive 6 7 equal credits that, in the aggregate, equal the amount of the disbursements received under this section, less a reasonable amount 8 to reimburse the entity for administering this section as 9 established by the commission in an amount not to exceed two percent 10 of the disbursements. The commission by rule shall ensure that the 11 customer is provided, with the customer's bill, notice that the 12 13 refund of the system benefit fund fee is "provided by the Texas <u>Legislature."</u> 14 15 (d) The comptroller and commission jointly shall issue a report on the progress made in developing and implementing the 16 system required to be established by Subsection (a), and in 17 disbursing the amount appropriated from the system benefit fund 18 through that system, not later than December 15, 2014. The report 19 20 issued under this subsection must be presented in writing to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of 21 representatives, and the standing committees of the senate and 22 house of representatives having primary jurisdiction over electric 23 24 utilities. 25 (e) The comptroller on September 1, 2014, shall deposit to

26 the credit of the system benefit fund any undisbursed balance of the 27 special fund.

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(f) This section expires September 1, 2015.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
