## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating	to	manufacturers	and	distributors	of	only	all

- 3 electric-powered or all battery-powered motor vehicles.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2301.476, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by adding subsection (i-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (i-1) Notwithstanding the terms of this chapter, and
- 8 subject to the limitations set forth in this subsection, a
- 9 manufacturer of only all electric-powered or all battery-powered
- 10 motor vehicles, or a distributor of only all electric-powered or
- 11 all battery-powered motor vehicles, that (i) owned and operated a
- 12 <u>new motor vehicle dealership in the United States on or before March</u>
- 13 <u>1, 2013, and (ii) has never sold its line make in the United States</u>
- 14 through an independent franchised new motor vehicle dealership, may
- 15 own or operate a dealer or dealership, or act in the capacity of a
- 16 dealer, at any location within the state and may obtain a dealer
- 17 general distinguishing number under Section 503.029 of the
- 18 Transportation Code.

- 19 SECTION 2. Section 2301.252(a), Occupations Code, is
- 20 amended by adding subsection (a)(3) to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A person may not engage in the business of buying,
- 22 selling, or exchanging new motor vehicles unless the person:
- 23 (1) holds a franchised dealer's license issued under
- 24 this chapter for the make of a new motor vehicle being bought, sold,

- 1 or exchanged; or
- 2 (2) is a bona fide employee of the holder of a
- 3 franchised dealer's license; or
- 4 (3) is a bona fide employee of a manufacturer or
- 5 <u>distributor authorized to own or operate a dealer or dealership</u>
- 6 pursuant to § 2301.476(i-1).
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
