## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to providing a federal postcard applicant with a ballot
- 3 for any election in which the applicant is eligible to vote.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 101.054, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) A person may apply with a single federal postcard
- 9 application for a ballot for any one or more elections in which the
- 10 person is eligible to vote [the early voting clerk to whom the
- 11 application is submitted conducts early voting].
- 12 (b) An application that does not identify the election for
- 13 which a ballot is requested shall be treated as if it requests a
- 14 ballot for:
- 15 (1) each general or special election held within one
- 16 year after the date the application is received in which the person
- 17 <u>is eligible to vote</u> [<u>in which the clerk conducts early voting</u>]; and
- 18 (2) the general primary election if the application
- 19 indicates party preference and is <u>received within one year before</u>
- 20 the date of the general primary election [submitted to the early
- 21 voting clerk for the primary].
- 22 (b-1) If an application under Subsection (b) indicates the
- 23 person is eligible to vote in an election in which the early voting
- 24 clerk who received the application does not conduct early voting,

- 1 the clerk shall forward a copy of the application in a form
- 2 prescribed by the secretary of state to each early voting clerk who
- 3 conducts early voting for an election in which the person is
- 4 eligible to vote.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
