- SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is 5
- amended by adding Section 51.979 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 51.979. TRANSPARENCY IN STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS. (a) 7
- this section, "general academic teaching institution" has the 8
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
- (b) Each general academic teaching institution shall 10
- include on a student's transcript, for each class attempted by the 11
- student, the average grade that was awarded to all students in the 12
- class. For a class for which letter grades are awarded, the 13
- 14 institution shall include on the transcript the median grade that
- was awarded to all students in the class. The institution shall 15
- place the average or median grade, as applicable, immediately to 16
- the right of the student's individual grade. 17
- 18 (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a class:
- 19 (1) offered to students solely on a pass-fail basis or
- for independent study credit; or 20
- 21 (2) in which grades are reported for 10 students or
- 22 fewer.
- (d) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall 23
- adopt rules to administer this section. 24

- 1 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 2 shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.979, Education Code,
- 3 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 4 effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may adopt the
- 5 initial rules in the manner provided by law for emergency rules.
- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 7 beginning with the 2013 fall semester.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
