6	SECTION 1. Section 654.037, Government Code, is amended by

8	(d) Each state fiscal biennium, the classification officer

10	(1) identify each agency of state government that
11	experienced an employee turnover or attrition rate exceeding 17
12	percent during the preceding state fiscal biennium;
13	(2) conduct with respect to each agency described by
14	Subdivision (1) a comparative study of salary rates at the agency as
15	described by Subsection (a)(1) and report the findings of those
16	studies as required by Subsection (a)(2); and
17	(3) include in its study and report for each agency
18	under this subsection:
19	(A) a comparison of the mean average salary
20	currently paid at the agency with the market average maximum base
21	pay for similar work performed in other governmental units and in
22	industry;
23	(B) a comparison of the mean average salary
24	currently paid at the agency with the market average mid-range base

- 1 pay for similar work performed in other governmental units and in
- 2 <u>industry; and</u>
- 3 (C) an analysis of the probable reasons for the
- 4 <u>high turnover or attrition rate.</u>
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
