S.B. No. 1729

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

and a county for the provision of renewal and duplicate driver's

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- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 521.008 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 521.008. PILOT PROGRAM REGARDING THE PROVISION OF
- 10 RENEWAL AND DUPLICATE DRIVER'S LICENSE AND OTHER IDENTIFICATION
- 11 CERTIFICATE SERVICES. (a) The department may establish a pilot
- 12 program for the provision of renewal and duplicate driver's
- 13 license, election identification certificate, and personal
- 14 identification certificate services in:
- 15 (1) not more than three counties with a population of
- 16 50,000 or less;
- 17 (2) not more than three counties with a population of
- 18 more than 50,000 but less than 1,000,001; and
- 19 (3) not more than two counties with a population of
- 20 more than 1 million.
- 21 (a-1) Under the pilot program, the department may enter into
- 22 an agreement with the commissioners court of a county to permit
- 23 county employees to provide services at a county office relating to
- 24 the issuance of renewal and duplicate driver's licenses, election

- 1 identification certificates, and personal identification
- 2 certificates, including:
- 4 (2) administering vision tests;
- 5 (3) updating a driver's license, election
- 6 identification certificate, or personal identification certificate
- 7 to change a name, address, or photograph;
- 8 <u>(4) distributing and collecting information relating</u>
- 9 to donations under Section 521.401;
- 10 (5) collecting fees; and
- 11 (6) performing other basic ministerial functions and
- 12 tasks necessary to issue renewal and duplicate driver's licenses,
- 13 election identification certificates, and personal identification
- 14 certificates.
- 15 (b) An agreement under Subsection (a-1) may not include
- 16 training to administer an examination for driver's license
- 17 applicants under Subchapter H.
- 18 (c) A participating county must remit to the department for
- 19 deposit as required by this chapter fees collected for the issuance
- 20 of a renewal or duplicate driver's license or personal
- 21 identification certificate.
- 22 (d) The commissioners court of a county may provide services
- 23 through any consenting county office. A county office may decline
- 24 or consent to provide services under this section by providing
- 25 written notice to the commissioners court.
- 26 (e) The department shall provide all equipment and supplies
- 27 necessary to perform the services described by Subsection (a-1),

- 1 <u>including network connectivity.</u>
- 2 <u>(f)</u> The department shall adopt rules to administer this
- 3 section.
- 4 SECTION 2. Subchapter R, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 5 is amended by adding Section 521.428 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 521.428. COUNTY FEE. A county that provides services
- 7 under an agreement described by Section 521.008 may collect an
- 8 additional fee of up to \$5 for each transaction provided that
- 9 relates to driver's license and personal identification
- 10 certificate services only.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
