## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to training requirements applicable to members of the

- 3 governing board of a public institution of higher education.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.084, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) and Subsection
- 7 (h) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The board by rule shall establish a training program for
- 9 members of the governing boards of institutions of higher
- 10 education. Each member of a governing board of an institution of
- 11 higher education shall attend, during the member's first year [two
- 12 **years**] of service as a member of a governing board of an institution
- 13 of higher education, at least one training program under this
- 14 section. A member of a governing board who is required to attend a
- 15 training program under this section may attend additional training
- 16 programs under this section.
- 17 <u>(a-1)</u> The board's rules must require a governing board
- 18 member as part of the training program to attend any available
- 19 training course sponsored or coordinated by the office of the
- 20 governor with a curriculum designed for training newly appointed
- 21 state officers, board members, or high-level executive officials.
- 22 The rules must require the member to attend the course the first
- 23 time the course is offered following the date the member takes the
- 24 oath of office, regardless of whether that attendance is required

- 1 under other law. The rules may provide a governing board member
- 2 additional time to attend the course if the member for good cause is
- 3 unable to attend the course the first time the course is offered.
- 4 Subsection (g) does not apply to the course required by this
- 5 subsection.
- 6 (h) The board is responsible for documenting completion of
- 7 the requirements in this Section.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 61.0841, Education Code, is added to
- 9 read as follows:
- Sec. 61.0841. INTENSE SHORT COURSE. (a) The board shall
- 11 develop an intense short orientation course that a governing board
- 12 member must complete before they vote at a meeting of the governing
- 13 board. The course can be a written document, an online interactive
- 14 course, or taken in a one-to-one or group setting.
- 15 (b) The content of the instruction provided by the course
- 16 shall include:
- 17 (1) best practices relating to excellence,
- 18 transparency, accountability, and efficiency in the governing
- 19 structure and organization of state university and state university
- 20 systems;
- 21 (2) best practices relating to the manner in which
- 22 governing boards and administrators of state universities and state
- 23 university systems develop and implement major policy decisions,
- 24 including impartiality and adequacy of their processes;
- 25 (3) matters relating to excellence, transparency,
- 26 accountability, and efficiency in the governance and
- 27 administration of the state's universities and university systems;

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- 1 <u>and</u>
- 2 (4) ethics, conflicts of interests, and the proper
- 3 role of a board member in the governance structure of state
- 4 universities and university systems.
- 5 (c) The board is responsible for documenting completion of
- 6 the requirements of this Section.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
