1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to a criminal penalty for failure to handle certain
1-18 animals in accordance with rules of the Texas Animal Health
1-19 Commission.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 161.041, Agriculture
1-22 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-23 (c) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
1-24 fails to handle, in accordance with rules adopted by the
1-25 commission, livestock, exotic livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic
1-26 fowl:

1-27 (1) infected with a disease listed in Subsection (a);
1-28 (2) exposed, as defined by commission rule, to a
1-29 disease listed in Subsection (a) if the commission has notified the
1-30 person that the animal was exposed to the disease; or

1-31 (3) subject to a testing requirement due to a risk of
1-32 exposure, as defined by commission rule, to a specific disease if
1-33 the commission has notified the person of the testing requirement.

1-34 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-35 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
1-36 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
1-37 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
1-38 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
1-39 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
1-40 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
1-41 before that date.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
