16	(b) A person commits an offense if the person with criminal
17	negligence purchases or possesses a license plate flipper. An
18	offense under this subsection is a Class B misdemeanor.
19	(c) A person commits an offense if the person with criminal
20	negligence manufactures, sells, offers to sell, or otherwise
21	distributes a license plate flipper. An offense under this
22	subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
