## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the reporting of health care-associated infections at
3	health care facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 98.103(a), (b), and (c), Health and
6	Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) A health care facility[ <del>, other than a pediatric and</del>
8	adolescent hospital, shall report to the department the incidence
9	of surgical site infections, including the causative pathogen if
10	the infection is laboratory-confirmed, occurring in the following
11	procedures:
12	(1) colon surgeries;
13	(2) hip arthroplasties;
14	(3) knee arthroplasties;
15	(4) abdominal hysterectomies;
16	(5) vaginal hysterectomies;
17	(6) coronary artery bypass grafts; [and]
18	(7) vascular procedures <u>;</u> [+]
19	(8) [(b) A pediatric and adolescent hospital shall
20	report the incidence of surgical site infections, including the
21	causative pathogen if the infection is laboratory-confirmed,
22	occurring in the following procedures to the department:
23	$[\frac{(1)}{1}]$ cardiac procedures, excluding thoracic cardiac
24	procedures;

- 1 (9) [(2)] ventricular shunt procedures; and
- 2 (10)  $\left[\frac{(3)}{3}\right]$  spinal surgery with instrumentation.
- 3 (b) [(c)] A [general] hospital shall report the following
- 4 to the department:
- 5 (1) the incidence of laboratory-confirmed central
- 6 line-associated primary bloodstream infections, including the
- 7 causative pathogen, occurring in any special care setting in the
- 8 hospital; [and]
- 9 (2) the incidence of respiratory syncytial virus
- 10 occurring in any pediatric inpatient unit in the hospital; and
- 11 (3) the incidence of specific infections designated by
- 12 <u>executive commissioner rule</u>.
- 13 SECTION 2. (a) The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 14 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 15 implement Section 98.103, Health and Safety Code, as amended by
- 16 this Act, not later than January 1, 2014.
- 17 (b) Section 98.103, Health and Safety Code, as amended by
- 18 this Act, applies only to a report for an infection occurring on or
- 19 after the effective date of this Act. A report for an infection
- 20 occurring before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 21 law as it existed on the date the infection occurred, and that law
- 22 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
