- 12 pipeline easement on the property owner's use and enjoyment of the
- property and, if applicable, the extent to which that effect will 13

- alternative routes proposed by the property owner before the 15
- 16 condemnation proceeding commenced;
- (2) the damage to the entirety of the owner's property 17
- that will result from the laying of the pipeline in the easement and 18
