## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to request, receipt, and maintenance of certain security
- 3 clearance by members of the Public Safety Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 411.036, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 411.0036. REMOVAL OF COMMISSION MEMBER. (a) It is a
- 8 ground for removal from the commission if a member:
- 9 (1) does not have at the time of appointment the
- 10 qualifications required by Section 411.003;
- 11 (2) does not maintain during service on the commission
- 12 the qualifications required by Section 411.003;
- 13 (3) does not request, receive, and maintain a federal
- 14 secret level security clearance;
- 15 (3)(4) violates a prohibition established by Section
- 16 411.0035;
- 17 (4)(5) cannot discharge the member's duties for a
- 18 substantial part of the term for which the member is appointed
- 19 because of illness or disability; or
- 20 (5)(6) is absent from more than half of the regularly
- 21 scheduled commission meetings that the member is eligible to attend
- 22 during a calendar year unless the absence is excused by majority
- 23 vote of the commission.
- 24 (b) The validity of an action of the commission is not

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- 1 affected by the fact that it is taken when a ground for removal of a
- 2 commission member exists.
- 3 (c) If the director has knowledge that a potential ground
- 4 for removal exists, the director shall notify the chairman of the
- 5 commission of the potential ground. The chairman shall then notify
- 6 the governor and the attorney general that a potential ground for
- 7 removal exists. If the potential ground for removal involves the
- 8 chairman, the director shall notify the member with the longest
- 9 tenure on the commission, other than the chairman, who shall then
- 10 notify the governor and the attorney general that a potential
- 11 ground for removal exists.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
