9	SECTION 2. Chapter 28A, Water Code, is amended by adding

12	Sec. 28A.071. LOCATION OF SAND MINE. A person may not
13	extract sand from the earth through a mining operation unless the
14	site of the mining operation is more than three miles from the
15	boundary of any property included in an identifiable unincorporated
16	community that uses groundwater from an aquifer for all or part of
17	its drinking water.
18	Sec. 28A.072. CIVIL ACTION. (a) A person may bring a civil
19	action against a person who violates Section 28A.071 if the person
20	bringing the civil action resides in a location or owns a place of
21	business that is less than three miles from the site of the sand
22	mine.
23	(b) In addition to any other remedy provided by law, a
24	person who brings an action under this section may seek injunctive

1 relief and actual damages sustained by the person.

(c) A plaintiff who prevails in an action brought under this
section is entitled to recover the amount of actual damages, if any,
as well as reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.

5 SECTION 3. Section 28A.102, Water Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

Sec. 28A.102. <u>PENALTIES</u> [<u>PENALTY</u>]. (a) The commission may assess a penalty of not less than \$5,000 and not more than \$10,000 for each year in which an aggregate production operation operates without being registered under this chapter. The total penalty under this section may not exceed \$25,000 for an aggregate production operation that is operated in three or more years without being registered.

14 (b) The commission may assess an administrative penalty
15 under Chapter 7 for a violation of Section 28A.071.

16 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an extraction that takes place on or after the effective date of 18 this Act. An extraction that takes place before the effective date 19 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the 20 extraction, and the former law is continued in effect for that 21 purpose.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
