S.B. No. 1827

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to an additional fee for filing civil cases in certain  
Rockwall County courts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 51, Government Code, is  
amended by adding Section 51.709 to read as follows:

Sec. 51.709. ADDITIONAL FILING FEE FOR CIVIL CASES IN  
ROCKWALL COUNTY. (a) This section applies only to district  
courts, statutory probate courts, county courts at law, and justice  
courts in Rockwall County.

(b) Except as otherwise provided by this section and in  
addition to all other fees authorized or required by other law, the  
clerk of a court shall collect a filing fee of not more than \$15 in  
each civil case filed in the court to be used for the construction,  
renovation, or improvement of the facilities that house the courts  
collecting the fee.

(c) Court fees due under this section shall be collected in  
the same manner as other fees, fines, or costs are collected in the  
case.

(d) The clerk shall send the fees collected under this  
section to the county treasurer at least as frequently as monthly.  
The treasurer shall deposit the fees in a special account in the  
county treasury dedicated to the construction, renovation, or  
improvement of the facilities that house the courts collecting the

1 fee.

2 (e) This section applies only to fees for a 12-month period  
3 beginning July 1, if the commissioners court:

4 (1) adopts a resolution authorizing a fee of not more  
5 than \$15; and

6 (2) files the resolution with the county treasurer not  
7 later than June 1 immediately preceding the first 12-month period  
8 during which the fees are to be collected.

9 (f) A resolution adopted under Subsection (e) continues  
10 from year to year until July 1, 2025, allowing the county to collect  
11 fees under the terms of this section until the resolution is  
12 rescinded.

13 (g) The commissioners court may rescind the resolution  
14 adopted under Subsection (e) by adopting a resolution rescinding  
15 the resolution and submitting the rescision resolution to the county  
16 treasurer not later than June 1 preceding the beginning of the first  
17 day of the county fiscal year. The commissioners court may adopt an  
18 additional resolution in the manner provided by Subsection (e)  
19 after rescinding a previous resolution under that subsection.

20 (h) A fee established under a particular resolution is  
21 abolished on the earlier of:

22 (1) the date a resolution adopted under Subsection (e)  
23 is rescinded as provided by Subsection (g); or

24 (2) July 1, 2025.

25 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 101, Government Code, is  
26 amended by adding Section 101.061191 to read as follows:

27 Sec. 101.061191. ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT FEES FOR COURT

1 FACILITIES: GOVERNMENT CODE. The clerk of a district court in  
2 Rockwall County shall collect an additional filing fee of not more  
3 than \$15 under Section 51.709 in civil cases to fund the  
4 construction, renovation, or improvement of court facilities, if  
5 authorized by the county commissioners court.

6 SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 101, Government Code, is  
7 amended by adding Section 101.08119 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 101.08119. ADDITIONAL STATUTORY COUNTY COURT FEES FOR  
9 COURT FACILITIES: GOVERNMENT CODE. The clerk of a statutory county  
10 court in Rockwall County shall collect an additional filing fee of  
11 not more than \$15 under Section 51.709 in civil cases to fund the  
12 construction, renovation, or improvement of court facilities, if  
13 authorized by the county commissioners court.

14 SECTION 4. Subchapter F, Chapter 101, Government Code, is  
15 amended by adding Section 101.10118 to read as follows:

16 Sec. 101.10118. ADDITIONAL STATUTORY PROBATE COURT FEES FOR  
17 COURT FACILITIES: GOVERNMENT CODE. The clerk of a statutory  
18 probate court in Rockwall County shall collect an additional filing  
19 fee of not more than \$15 under Section 51.709 in civil cases to fund  
20 the construction, renovation, or improvement of court facilities,  
21 if authorized by the county commissioners court.

22 SECTION 5. Subchapter H, Chapter 101, Government Code, is  
23 amended by adding Section 101.142 to read as follows:

24 Sec. 101.142. ADDITIONAL JUSTICE COURT FEE FOR COURT  
25 FACILITIES COLLECTED BY CLERK. The clerk of a justice court in  
26 Rockwall County shall collect an additional filing fee of not more  
27 than \$15 under Section 51.709 in civil cases to fund the

1 construction, renovation, or improvement of court facilities, if  
2 authorized by the county commissioners court.

3           SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
