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- 2 relating to the powers and duties of Fort Bend County Municipal
- 3 Utility District No. 194.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 8317.002(b), Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
- 8 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that relate to the
- 9 construction, acquisition, [or] improvement, operation, or
- 10 maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads [described by
- 11 Section 54.234, Water Code], or improvements, including storm
- 12 drainage, in aid of those roads.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 8317.053, Special District Local Laws
- 14 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 8317.053. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. [(a)] Under
- 16 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
- 17 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve,
- 18 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a
- 19 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled,
- 20 or paved roads [described by Section 54.234, Water Code], or
- 21 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.
- 22 [(b) The district may exercise the powers provided by this
- 23 section without submitting a petition to or obtaining approval from
- 24 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by

1 Section 54.234, Water Code.

- 2 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 8317, Special District
- 3 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 8317.0541 to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 Sec. 8317.0541. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A
- 6 road project must meet all applicable construction standards,
- 7 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each
- 8 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
- 9 jurisdiction the road project is located.
- 10 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
- 11 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
- 12 project must meet all applicable construction standards,
- 13 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
- 14 the road project is located.
- 15 <u>(c)</u> If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
- 16 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
- 17 specifications of the road project.
- 18 SECTION 4. Section 8317.054, Special District Local Laws
- 19 Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 5. Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No.
- 21 194 retains all rights, powers, privileges, authority, duties, and
- 22 functions that it had before the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 6. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all
- 24 governmental acts and proceedings of the Fort Bend County Municipal
- 25 Utility District No. 194 that were taken before the effective date
- 26 of this Act.
- (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the

- 1 effective date of this Act:
- 2 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 3 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
- 4 judgment; or
- 5 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.
- 6 SECTION 7. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 7 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 8 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 9 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 10 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 11 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 12 Government Code.
- 13 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 14 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 15 Environmental Quality.
- 16 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 17 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 18 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 19 representatives within the required time.
- 20 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 21 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 22 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 23 and accomplished.
- 24 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
