- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3861.052, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 3861.052. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS [ELECTION DATE].
- 8 The mayor and members of the governing body of the city shall
- 9 appoint directors. A person is appointed if the majority of those
- 10 members and the mayor vote to appoint that person [The board shall
- 11 hold elections for directors on the uniform election date in May in
- 12 even-numbered years].
- 13 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
- 14 the entitlement of a director serving on the board of directors of
- 15 the Viridian Municipal Management District immediately before the
- 16 effective date of this Act to continue to carry out the board's
- 17 functions for the remainder of the director's term. As the
- 18 directors' terms expire, the mayor and members of the governing
- 19 body of the city shall replace the elected directors beginning with
- 20 the directors whose terms expire May 31, 2014.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
