S.B. No. 1837

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the appointment of directors for the Viridian Municipal
3 Management District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 3861.052, Special District Local Laws
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 3861.052. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS [~~ELECTION DATE~~].
8 The mayor and members of the governing body of the city shall
9 appoint directors. A person is appointed if the majority of those
10 members and the mayor vote to appoint that person [~~The board shall~~
11 ~~hold elections for directors on the uniform election date in May in~~
12 ~~even-numbered years~~].

13 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
14 the entitlement of a director serving on the board of directors of
15 the Viridian Municipal Management District immediately before the
16 effective date of this Act to continue to carry out the board's
17 functions for the remainder of the director's term. As the
18 directors' terms expire, the mayor and members of the governing
19 body of the city shall replace the elected directors beginning with
20 the directors whose terms expire May 31, 2014.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

1 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
