- 6 SECTION 1. Subdivision (4), Section 211.001, Property Code,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (4) "Residential real estate subdivision" or
- 9 "subdivision" means all land encompassed within one or more maps or
- 10 plats of land that is divided into two or more parts if:
- 11 (A) the maps or plats cover land all or part of
- 12 which is not located within a municipality and:
- 13 (i) for a county with a population of less
- 14 than 65,000, is not located within the extraterritorial
- 15 jurisdiction of a municipality; [or]
- 16 (ii) for a county with a population of at
- 17 least 65,000 and less than 135,000, is located wholly within the
- 18 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality; or
- 19 <u>(iii) for a county that borders Lake</u>
- 20 Buchanan and has a population of at least 18,500 and less than
- 21 19,500, is located wholly within the extraterritorial jurisdiction
- 22 of a municipality;
- 23 (B) the land encompassed within the maps or plats
- 24 is or was burdened by restrictions limiting all or at least a

- 1 majority of the land area covered by the map or plat, excluding
- 2 streets and public areas, to residential use only; and
- 3 (C) all instruments creating the restrictions
- 4 are recorded in the deed or real property records of a county.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 211.002, Property Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This chapter applies only to a residential real estate
- 8 subdivision or any unit or parcel of a subdivision:
- 9 (1) all or part of which is located within an
- 10 unincorporated area of a county if the county has a population of
- 11 less than 65,000; [<del>or</del>]
- 12 (2) all of which is located within the
- 13 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality located in a county
- 14 that has a population of at least 65,000 and less than 135,000; or
- 15 (3) all of which is located within the
- 16 extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality located in a county
- 17 that borders Lake Buchanan and has a population of at least 18,500
- 18 and less than 19,500.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 4, Chapter 129, Acts of
- 20 the 70th Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, is amended to read as
- 21 follows:
- (b) Bonds may not be issued by the district under this Act
- 23 except on approval of not less than <u>a majority</u> [two thirds] of the
- 24 qualified voters of the district voting at an election called and
- 25 held for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act to Subsection
- 27 (b), Section 4, Chapter 129, Acts of the 70th Legislature, Regular

- 1 Session, 1987, applies to an election to authorize the issuance of
- 2 bonds held on or after the effective date of this Act. An election
- 3 to authorize the issuance of bonds held before the effective date of
- 4 this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the election
- 5 was held, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 6 purpose.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
