## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of board members for emergency services
- 3 districts in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (h), Section 775.034, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) This section does not apply to a district located wholly
- 8 in a county:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> with a population of more than three million; or
- 10 (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that
- 11 borders Lake Palestine.
- 12 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 775.0345, Health and
- 13 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 775.0345. ELECTION OF BOARD IN CERTAIN [POPULOUS]
- 15 COUNTIES.
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 775.0345, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended by amending Subsections (a), (b), (e), (f), and (g) and
- 18 adding Subsections (b-1), (d-1), and (h-1) to read as follows:
- 19 (a) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 20 in a county:
- 21 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that
- 23 borders Lake Palestine.
- 24 (b) The governing body of a district consists of a

- 1 five-person board of emergency services commissioners elected as
- 2 prescribed by this section. Except as provided by <u>Subsections (h)</u>
- 3 and (h-1) [Subsection (h)], emergency services commissioners serve
- 4 four-year terms.
- 5 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the governing body of
- 6 a district described by Subsection (a)(2) is governed by a
- 7 five-member board of emergency services commissioners elected from
- 8 single-member districts. One director is elected from each
- 9 <u>single-member district</u>. As soon as possible after the district is
- 10 created, the commissioners court of the county in which the
- 11 district is located shall divide the district into five numbered
- 12 single-member districts.
- 13 (d-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (d), to be eligible to be a
- 14 candidate for emergency services commissioner in a single-member
- 15 district on an initial board in a district described by Subsection
- 16 (a)(2), a person must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of
- 17 <u>that single-member district.</u>
- 18 (e) A candidate for emergency services commissioner on an
- 19 initial board must give the voter registrar of the county [clerk] a
- 20 sworn notice of the candidate's intention to run for office. The
- 21 notice must state the person's name, age, and address and state that
- 22 the person is serving notice of intent to run for emergency services
- 23 commissioner. If the person intends to run for emergency services
- 24 <u>commissioner in a single-member district in a dist</u>rict described by
- 25 Subsection (a)(2), the notice must also specify the single-member
- 26 <u>district the person seeks to represent.</u> On receipt of the notice,
- 27 the voter registrar of the county [clerk] shall have the

- 1 candidate's name placed on the ballot.
- 2 (f) The voter registrar of the county [clerk] shall appoint
- 3 an election judge to certify the results of the election.
- 4 (g) After the election is held, the voter registrar or
- 5 deputy registrar of the county [clerk or the clerk's deputy] shall
- 6 prepare a sworn statement of the election costs incurred by the
- 7 county. The statement shall be given to the newly elected board,
- 8 which shall order the appropriate official to reimburse the county
- 9 for the county's election costs.
- 10 (h-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (h), the five initial
- 11 emergency services commissioners elected from single-member
- 12 districts in a district described by Subsection (a)(2) shall draw
- 13 lots to determine which two commissioners serve terms that expire
- 14 on December 31 of the second year following the year in which the
- 15 election was held and which three commissioners serve terms that
- 16 expire on December 31 of the fourth year following the year in which
- 17 the election was held.
- 18 SECTION 4. The heading to Section 775.0355, Health and
- 19 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 775.0355. DISQUALIFICATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
- 21 COMMISSIONERS IN CERTAIN [POPULOUS] COUNTIES.
- SECTION 5. Subsection (b), Section 775.0355, Health and
- 23 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 24 (b) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 25 in a county:
- 26 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- 27 (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that

- 1 borders Lake Palestine.
- 2 SECTION 6. The heading to Section 775.0445, Health and
- 3 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 775.0445. VACANCY ON BOARD OF DISTRICT LOCATED IN
- 5 CERTAIN [POPULOUS] COUNTIES.
- 6 SECTION 7. Subsection (b), Section 775.0445, Health and
- 7 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 9 in a county:
- 10 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- 11 (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that
- 12 borders Lake Palestine.
- 13 SECTION 8. (a) This Act does not prohibit a person who is
- 14 an emergency services commissioner on the effective date of this
- 15 Act and who was appointed under Section 775.034, Health and Safety
- 16 Code, from running for election to the board if the person has the
- 17 qualifications required for a member under Section 775.0345, Health
- 18 and Safety Code, as amended by this Act.
- 19 (b) The terms of the members of a board of emergency
- 20 services commissioners serving on the effective date of this Act
- 21 who were appointed under Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code,
- 22 before the effective date of this Act expire on the date a majority
- 23 of the members of the initial board of emergency services
- 24 commissioners elected under Subsection (c) of this section qualify
- 25 to serve.
- 26 (c) The county judge of a county with an emergency services
- 27 district to which Subdivision (2), Subsection (a), Section

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- 1 775.0345, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies on
- 2 the effective date of this Act and to which Section 775.034, Health
- 3 and Safety Code, previously applied shall establish an election to
- 4 elect the initial emergency services commissioners of that district
- 5 in the manner required by Subsections (c) through (h), Section
- 6 775.0345, Health and Safety Code, for election of the initial
- 7 commissioners as if the district had been created on the effective
- 8 date of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
