- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 775.034(h), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) This section does not apply to a district located wholly
- 8 in a county:
- 9 (1) with a population of more than three million; or
- 10 (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that
- 11 borders Lake Palestine.
- 12 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 775.0345, Health and
- 13 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 775.0345. ELECTION OF BOARD IN CERTAIN [POPULOUS]
- 15 COUNTIES.
- 16 SECTION 3. Sections 775.0345(a), (e), (f), and (g), Health
- 17 and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) This section applies only to a district located wholly
- 19 in a county:
- 20 <u>(1)</u> with a population of more than three million; or
- 21 (2) with a population of more than 200,000 that
- 22 borders Lake Palestine.
- (e) A candidate for emergency services commissioner on an
- 24 initial board must give the voter registrar of the county [clerk] a

- 1 sworn notice of the candidate's intention to run for office. The
- 2 notice must state the person's name, age, and address and state that
- 3 the person is serving notice of intent to run for emergency services
- 4 commissioner. On receipt of the notice, the voter registrar of the
- 5 county [clerk] shall have the candidate's name placed on the
- 6 ballot.
- 7 (f) The <u>voter registrar of the</u> county [<del>clerk</del>] shall appoint
- 8 an election judge to certify the results of the election.
- 9 (g) After the election is held, the voter registrar or
- 10 <u>deputy registrar of the</u> county [<del>clerk or the clerk's deputy</del>] shall
- 11 prepare a sworn statement of the election costs incurred by the
- 12 county. The statement shall be given to the newly elected board,
- 13 which shall order the appropriate official to reimburse the county

- 10 SECTION 8. (a) This Act does not prohibit a person who is a
- 11 commissioner on the effective date of this Act and who was appointed
- 12 under Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code, from running for
- 13 election to the board if the person has the qualifications required
- 14 for a member under Section 775.0345, Health and Safety Code, as
- 15 amended by this Act.
- 16 (b) The terms of the members of a board of emergency
- 17 services commissioners serving on the effective date of this Act
- 18 who were appointed under Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code,
- 19 before the effective date of this Act expire on the date a majority
- 20 of the members of the initial board of emergency services
- 21 commissioners elected under Subsection (c) of this section qualify
- 22 to serve.
- (c) The county judge of a county with an emergency services
- 24 district to which Section 775.0345(a)(2), Health and Safety Code,
- 25 as added by this Act, applies on the effective date of this Act and
- 26 to which Section 775.034, Health and Safety Code, previously
- 27 applied, shall establish an election to elect the initial emergency

- 1 services commissioners of that district in the manner required by
- 2 Sections 775.0345(c)-(h), Health and Safety Code, for election of
- 3 the initial commissioners as if the district had been created on the
- 4 effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
