## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to information for legislative purposes requested under

3 the Public Information Act.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.008, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsections (d) and (d-1) to read as follows:
- (d) A governmental body shall promptly produce information 7 requested under this section. In this subsection, "promptly" means 8 as soon as possible under the circumstances, that is, within a 9 10 reasonable time, without delay. If the governmental body cannot produce public information for inspection or duplication within 10 11 business days after the date the information is requested under 12 this section, the governmental body shall certify that fact in 13 writing to the requestor and set a date and hour within a reasonable 14 15 time when the information will be available for inspection or duplication. 16
- 17 (d-1) A governmental body on request by an individual
  18 member, agency, or committee of the legislature shall provide the
  19 information requested under this section as it becomes available
  20 and may not delay producing any available information on the
  21 grounds that all of the information that must be produced under the
  22 request is not yet available for release.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
