- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.008, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (d) and (d-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A governmental body shall promptly produce information
- 8 requested under this section. In this subsection, "promptly" means
- 9 as soon as possible under the circumstances, that is, within a
- 10 reasonable time, without delay. If the governmental body cannot
- 11 produce public information for inspection or duplication within 10
- 12 business days after the date the information is requested under
- 13 this section, the governmental body shall certify that fact in
- 14 writing to the requestor and set a date and hour within a reasonable
- 15 time when the information will be available for inspection or
- 16 duplication.
- 17 (d-1) A governmental body on request by an individual
- 18 member, agency, or committee of the legislature shall provide the
- 19 information requested under this section as it becomes available
- 20 and may not delay producing any available information on the
- 21 grounds that all of the information that must be produced under the
- 22 request is not yet available for release.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
