CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Texas offers numerous opportunities for residents
- 2 and visitors to take part in water-related recreation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, While the benefits of such activities are many, it
- 4 is vitally important that proper measures be taken to avoid
- 5 accidents; whether individuals are enjoying lakes, rivers, the Gulf
- 6 of Mexico, or a public or private pool, water safety is essential to
- 7 preventing drowning and injuries; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Each year, more than 100 Texas children die from
- 9 drowning, making it one of the leading causes of childhood injury
- 10 deaths; moreover, the rates of drowning-related deaths in the state
- 11 are consistently higher than the national average; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Studies of seasonal variations have shown that
- 13 two-thirds of the drowning deaths of young children and adolescents
- 14 occur in the months of May through August; raising awareness of this
- 15 issue in advance of the summer months will encourage the citizens of
- 16 the Lone Star State to exercise caution and will help reinforce the
- 17 message that water safety is everyone's responsibility; now,
- 18 therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas
- 20 hereby designate April as Water Safety Month; and, be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 22 391.004(d), Government Code, the designation expires on the 10th
- 23 anniversary of the date this resolution is passed by the
- 24 legislature.
