- 10 First Monday Trade Days, an event which draws about 180,000
- 11 visitors to the city each month; the average person attending First
- 12 Monday walks at least a mile and a half while browsing on the
- 13 350-acre grounds; and
- WHEREAS, City leaders have also established a monthly mayor's
- 15 walk at Cherry Creek Park; people of all ages are encouraged to take
- 16 part in this healthful activity; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The people of Canton have demonstrated initiative
- 18 and foresight in taking the matter of public health into their own
- 19 hands, and it is truly fitting that the city be recognized as the
- 20 Walking Capital of Texas; now, therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas
- 22 hereby declare the City of Canton to be the Walking Capital of
- 23 Texas; and, be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be prepared in honor
