## 1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1727 has been adopted by the house of
- 3 representatives and the senate; and
- WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the senate be instructed to make the
- 8 following corrections:
- 9 (1) In the SECTION of the bill that amends Section 386.104,
- 10 Health and Safety Code, in added Subsection (f-1) of the section as
- 11 amended on third reading by Floor Amendment No. 1 by Isaac, strike
- 12 "the conversion of heavy-duty diesel on-road vehicle engines or
- 13 <u>stationary engines</u>" and substitute "the conversion of heavy-duty
- 14 <u>diesel on-road vehicle engines or non-road engines</u>".
- 15 (2) Strike the SECTION of the bill that amends Section
- 16 386.158, Health and Safety Code, and substitute the following
- 17 appropriately numbered SECTION:
- SECTION \_\_\_\_. Sections 386.158(a) and (c), Health and
- 19 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 20 (a) A person who purchases or leases a new light-duty motor
- 21 vehicle described by Section 386.153 and [that has been] listed
- 22 under Section 386.156(a) [386.155] is eligible to apply for an
- 23 incentive under this subchapter.
- (c) To receive money under an incentive program provided by

- 1 this subchapter, the purchaser or lessee of a new light-duty motor
- 2 vehicle who is eligible to apply for an incentive under this
- 3 subchapter shall apply for the incentive in the manner provided by
- 4 law or by rule of the commission [comptroller].
- 5 (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 6 the bill:
- 7 SECTION \_\_\_\_. Section 386.058(b), Health and Safety Code,
- 8 is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The governor shall appoint to the advisory board:
- 10 (1) a representative of the trucking industry;
- 11 (2) a representative of the air conditioning
- 12 manufacturing industry;
- 13 (3) a representative of the electric utility industry;
- 14 (4) a representative of regional transportation; and
- 15 (5) a representative of the nonprofit organization
- 16 described by Section 387.002 [386.252(a)(2)].
- SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 386.160, Health and Safety Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 386.160. COMMISSION [COMPTROLLER] TO ACCOUNT FOR MOTOR
- 20 VEHICLE PURCHASE OR LEASE INCENTIVES. (a) The commission
- 21 [comptroller] by rule shall develop a method to administer and
- 22 account for the motor vehicle purchase or lease incentives
- 23 authorized by this subchapter and to pay incentive money to the
- 24 purchaser or lessee of a new motor vehicle, on application of the
- 25 purchaser or lessee as provided by this subchapter.
- 26 (b) The commission [comptroller] shall develop and publish
- 27 forms and instructions for the purchaser or lessee of a new motor

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- 1 vehicle to use in applying to the commission [comptroller] for an
- 2 incentive payment under this subchapter. The commission
- 3 [comptroller] shall make the forms available to new motor vehicle
- 4 dealers and leasing agents. Dealers and leasing agents shall make
- 5 the forms available to their prospective purchasers or lessees.
- 6 (c) In addition to other forms developed and published under
- 7 this section, the  $\underline{\text{commission}}$  [ $\underline{\text{comptroller}}$ ] shall develop and
- 8 publish a verification form by which, with information provided by
- 9 the dealer or leasing agent, the commission [comptroller] can
- 10 verify the sale of a vehicle covered by this subchapter. The
- 11 verification form shall include at least the name of the purchaser,
- 12 the vehicle identification number of the vehicle involved, the date
- 13 of the purchase, and the name of the new motor dealer or leasing
- 14 agent involved in the transaction. At the time of sale or lease of a
- 15 vehicle eligible for an incentive under this subchapter, the dealer
- 16 or leasing agent shall complete the verification form supplied to
- 17 the dealer by the  $\underline{\text{commission}}$  [ $\underline{\text{comptroller}}$ ]. The purchaser or
- 18 lessee shall include the completed verification form as part of the
- 19 purchaser's application for an incentive. The dealer shall
- 20 maintain a copy of the completed verification form for at least two
- 21 years from the date of the transaction.
- 22 SECTION \_\_\_\_. The heading to Section 386.161, Health and
- 23 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 386.161. [REPORT TO COMMISSION;] SUSPENSION OF
- 25 PURCHASE OR LEASE INCENTIVES.
- 26 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Sections 386.161(b), (c), and (d), Health and
- 27 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

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- 1 If the balance available for motor vehicle purchase or (b) 2 lease incentives falls below 15 percent of the total allocated for incentives during that fiscal year, 3 the the commission 4 [comptroller] by order shall suspend the incentives until the date the comptroller can certify that the balance available in the fund 5 for incentives is an amount adequate to resume the incentives or the 6 7 beginning of the next fiscal year, whichever is earlier. commission [comptroller] suspends the incentives, the commission 8 9 [comptroller] shall immediately notify [the commission and] all new motor vehicle dealers and leasing agents that the incentives have 10 11 been suspended.
- (c) The <u>commission</u> [<del>comptroller</del>] shall establish a toll-free telephone number available to motor vehicle dealers and leasing agents for the dealers and agents to call to verify that incentives are available. The <u>commission</u> [<del>comptroller</del>] may provide for issuing verification numbers over the telephone line.
- (d) Reliance by a dealer or leasing agent on information provided by the [comptroller or] commission is a complete defense to an action involving or based on eligibility of a vehicle for an incentive or availability of vehicles eligible for an incentive.
- 21 (4) In the SECTION of the bill repealing provisions of the 22 law, add the following appropriately numbered subdivision and 23 renumber the subsequent subdivisions of the SECTION accordingly:
- 24 (\_\_\_) Section 386.161(a), Health and Safety Code;
- 25 (5) Renumber the SECTIONS of the bill accordingly.
