CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1727 has been adopted by the house of
- 2 representatives and the senate; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 4 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 5 RESOLVED by the 83rd Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 6 the enrolling clerk of the senate be instructed to make the
- 7 following corrections:
- 8 (1) In the SECTION of the bill that amends Section 386.104,
- 9 Health and Safety Code, in added Subsection (f-1) of the section as
- 10 amended on third reading by Floor Amendment No. 1 by Isaac, strike
- 11 "the conversion of heavy-duty diesel on-road vehicle engines or
- 12 stationary engines" and substitute "the conversion of heavy-duty
- 13 <u>diesel on-road vehicle engines or non-road engines</u>".
- 14 (2) Strike the SECTION of the bill that amends Section
- 15 386.158, Health and Safety Code, and substitute the following
- 16 appropriately numbered SECTION:
- SECTION ____. Sections 386.158(a) and (c), Health and
- 18 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) A person who purchases or leases a new light-duty motor
- 20 vehicle described by Section 386.153 and [that has been] listed
- 21 under Section 386.156(a) [386.155] is eligible to apply for an
- 22 incentive under this subchapter.
- (c) To receive money under an incentive program provided by
- 24 this subchapter, the purchaser or lessee of a new light-duty motor

- 1 vehicle who is eligible to apply for an incentive under this
- 2 subchapter shall apply for the incentive in the manner provided by
- 3 law or by rule of the commission [comptroller].
- 4 (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to
- 5 the bill:
- 6 SECTION ____. Section 386.058(b), Health and Safety Code,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The governor shall appoint to the advisory board:
- 9 (1) a representative of the trucking industry;
- 10 (2) a representative of the air conditioning
- 11 manufacturing industry;
- 12 (3) a representative of the electric utility industry;
- 13 (4) a representative of regional transportation; and
- 14 (5) a representative of the nonprofit organization
- 15 described by Section 387.002 [386.252(a)(2)].
- 16 SECTION ____. Section 386.160, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 386.160. COMMISSION [COMPTROLLER] TO ACCOUNT FOR MOTOR
- 19 VEHICLE PURCHASE OR LEASE INCENTIVES. (a) The commission
- 20 [comptroller] by rule shall develop a method to administer and
- 21 account for the motor vehicle purchase or lease incentives
- 22 authorized by this subchapter and to pay incentive money to the
- 23 purchaser or lessee of a new motor vehicle, on application of the
- 24 purchaser or lessee as provided by this subchapter.
- 25 (b) The commission [comptroller] shall develop and publish
- 26 forms and instructions for the purchaser or lessee of a new motor
- 27 vehicle to use in applying to the commission [comptroller] for an

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- 1 incentive payment under this subchapter. The commission
- 2 [comptroller] shall make the forms available to new motor vehicle
- 3 dealers and leasing agents. Dealers and leasing agents shall make
- 4 the forms available to their prospective purchasers or lessees.
- 5 (c) In addition to other forms developed and published under
- 6 this section, the $\underline{\text{commission}}$ [$\underline{\text{comptroller}}$] shall develop and
- 7 publish a verification form by which, with information provided by
- 8 the dealer or leasing agent, the commission [comptroller] can
- 9 verify the sale of a vehicle covered by this subchapter. The
- 10 verification form shall include at least the name of the purchaser,
- 11 the vehicle identification number of the vehicle involved, the date
- 12 of the purchase, and the name of the new motor dealer or leasing
- 13 agent involved in the transaction. At the time of sale or lease of a
- 14 vehicle eligible for an incentive under this subchapter, the dealer
- 15 or leasing agent shall complete the verification form supplied to
- 16 the dealer by the commission [comptroller]. The purchaser or
- 17 lessee shall include the completed verification form as part of the
- 18 purchaser's application for an incentive. The dealer shall
- 19 maintain a copy of the completed verification form for at least two
- 20 years from the date of the transaction.
- 21 SECTION ____. The heading to Section 386.161, Health and
- 22 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 386.161. [REPORT TO COMMISSION;] SUSPENSION OF
- 24 PURCHASE OR LEASE INCENTIVES.
- 25 SECTION _____. Sections 386.161(b), (c), and (d), Health and
- 26 Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 27 (b) If the balance available for motor vehicle purchase or

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- 1 lease incentives falls below 15 percent of the total allocated for
- 2 the incentives during that fiscal year, the commission
- 3 [comptroller] by order shall suspend the incentives until the date
- 4 the comptroller can certify that the balance available in the fund
- 5 for incentives is an amount adequate to resume the incentives or the
- 6 beginning of the next fiscal year, whichever is earlier. If the
- 7 commission [comptroller] suspends the incentives, the commission
- 8 [comptroller] shall immediately notify [the commission and] all new
- 9 motor vehicle dealers and leasing agents that the incentives have
- 10 been suspended.
- 11 (c) The <u>commission</u> [comptroller] shall establish a
- 12 toll-free telephone number available to motor vehicle dealers and
- 13 leasing agents for the dealers and agents to call to verify that
- 14 incentives are available. The commission [comptroller] may provide
- 15 for issuing verification numbers over the telephone line.
- 16 (d) Reliance by a dealer or leasing agent on information
- 17 provided by the [comptroller or] commission is a complete defense
- 18 to an action involving or based on eligibility of a vehicle for an
- 19 incentive or availability of vehicles eligible for an incentive.
- 20 (4) In the SECTION of the bill repealing provisions of the
- 21 law, add the following appropriately numbered subdivision and
- 22 renumber the subsequent subdivisions of the SECTION accordingly:
- 23 (___) Section 386.161(a), Health and Safety Code;
- 24 (5) Renumber the SECTIONS of the bill accordingly.
