## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the taxation of
- 2 the sale or use of certain food, drinks, and medicine.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 28 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 28. The legislature may not enact a general law that
- 7 would impose a state tax on the sale or use of:
- 8 (1) food or a drink that was not subject to taxation
- 9 under Chapter 151, Tax Code, on January 1, 2013; or
- 10 (2) a medicine that was not subject to taxation under
- 11 Chapter 151, Tax Code, on January 1, 2013.
- 12 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 13 the Texas Constitution:
- 14 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 15 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 83rd Legislature,
- 16 Regular Session, 2013, prohibiting the taxation of the sale or use
- 17 of certain food, drinks, and medicine, and expires December 31,
- 18 2015.
- 19 <u>(b) If the 83rd Legislature, during the regular or a special</u>
- 20 session, enacts a general law prohibited by Section 28, Article
- 21 VIII, of this constitution, the portion of the general law that
- 22 violates that section expires January 1, 2015.
- 23 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 24 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2013.
